1586	Olives	100	"	bloom is good, too early to judge set
4897	Grapes	100	"	very early estimate
4384	Pears	65	"	frost damage pretty severe in some areas
6357	Peaches	65	"	spotted frost damage quite severe in places.
604	Plums	80	"	frost in some districts
48	Prunes		"	small acreage
22569	Walnuts	100	"	some sections hurt by frost but other districts set above normal, injury confined to lesser districts
